## Solution

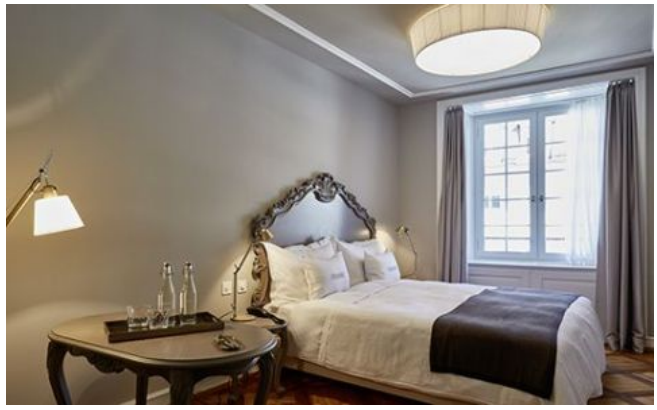
