Solution

For the renovation of the main entrance hall, the designers at McFarlane Latter sought a textile solution that would provide privacy while maintaining transparency.

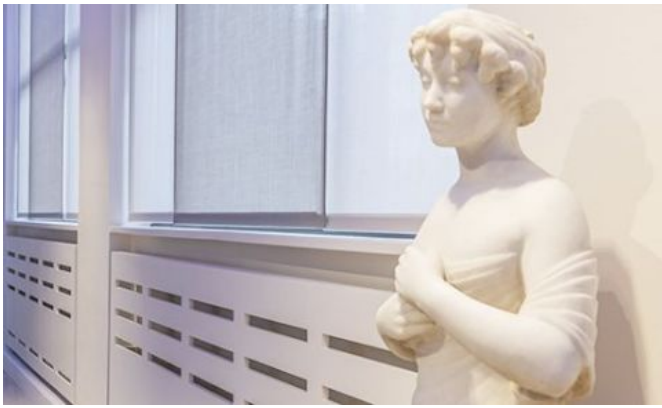

The combination of the curtain fabric with the Pantric panel curtain system with SONOR III 0321 and 0223 and the Rolltrac manual roller blind system with SONOR III R 7321 combines design with technical sophistication.
